## **Optimize Your Prosperity!**

I once gave a multi-millionaire a gift she has never forgotten. It didn't cost much, but I set in motion a spiritual law of prosperity and was enormously blessed in return.

In ministerial school a TV personality, broadcast journalist visited our campus and offered to meet with each student to coach us on professional speaking. Years before she had married a multi-millionaire, so she retired and chose to volunteer her time helping others with professional speaking. She set up 15-minute appointments over two days and each student could sign up for a time slot. My appointment was her last one, at the end of the second day.

Before meeting with her, I felt so grateful for her complimentary coaching that I wrote a thank you card and enclosed a check for \$25.00. When I met with her, I gave her the card and told her there was "a little something" in it for her and while it in no way came close to her normal coaching fees, I could see she was deeply touched.

We had a great session, and she gave me some very valuable pointers. Then she shared that she had met with 31 students, and while all were very appreciative, I was the only one who brought a thank you card. I reminded her that in Unity we teach it's a good spiritual practice to "give thanks in advance." A few days later she sent me a note telling me she would not be cashing my check but wrote she would be framing it and hanging it in her office.

During our meeting she also shared she mentored a group of new, young millionaires helping them understand their wealth was "more than money." In their monthly meeting, she told them what I had done. But the story doesn't end there.

My giving sparked her faith in me. She followed up and offered to support me financially in a business project she was launching to help women. She took out a full-page ad in the local paper with my photo promoting the project (and me) and gifted me \$1,000 just to get started. For this non-employed, seminary student, it was a pretty good (and almost instant) return on my \$25 giving, yes?

Charles Fillmore reminded us, "Many people try to demonstrate God as their supply by repeating affirmations of abundance now present but fail to deny their belief in lack by beginning to give as generously as possible."

Spiritual law requires we keep all our good in circulation or there is stagnation and loss. Food kept too long spoils. Clothes held back "for good" go out of fashion. Unused equipment rusts. Ideas not used fade. Money not used has no power for increase. It's been said that riches should circulate through our lives like air through our lungs. There is no robust life without inhale and exhale, nor prosperity without give and receive.

We are blessed by the wonderful Prayer Chaplains at Unity of Auburn! As spirit-led individuals, they completed the Unity Prayer Chaplain Program training, giving selfless, dedicated service to members of our congregation.

You have seen us stand and claim our Divine Connection in what is called "Holding Sacred Space" in our Sunday services. "Holding Sacred Space" is to hold in consciousness (awareness) a place of possibilities. Knowing we are not alone in our human situations means that regardless of the circumstance, situation, etc., each Chaplain KNOWS that God as Divine Nature is greater....and from this awareness holds presence and power in the moment and as the moment. In listening from the heart and not from the head, the prayer Chaplain follows what Myrtle Fillmore, co-founder of Unity, said in her book "Healing Letters":

"As you learn to see the fullness of God's life and love and power and substance in yourself and in others, you will know that you need not pour out your own for them. You will have the knowledge and the light to call their attention to what they have and to prompt them to use it."

In this role as Chaplain, practicing prayer helps me return, again and again, to moments of quiet assurance that I am choosing connection, daily, with the Oneness of God, beginning, each time, that place of resiliency for what shows up. In sharing prayer with our congregants, I am renewed in my path to deepen my own awareness of God as Source and to hold that spiritual space for others through prayer and listening.
