Are you concerned about the well-being of some other person? Are you worried because you do not see how a loved one will be able to meet some situation or work out his problems? Are you fearful because of a loved one's physical or mental condition?

Even though you may not see how another person's needs can be met, lift up our faith and place him or her in God's care. Free your mind from anxious thoughts, free your heart from fearful feelings. Your greatest prayer for another is the realization that God is within him, a power for good, a moving force that heals, loves, guides, and blesses.
