A twenty-six page manuscript dated to the 3rd or 4th century and written in the Sahidic dialect of Coptic was found in the Egyptian desert in the 1970's. Then it vanished into the world of antiquities traders. In 1983 a graduate student working in Rome, got a call from a fellow scholar to travel to Switzerland to check out some Coptic documents being offered from a mysterious source. In Geneva the two men were directed to a hotel room where they were given thirty minutes to look into what were effectively three shoe boxes. Inside were papers. They were not allowed to take photographs or make any notes. The papers were already beginning to crumble – so they lifted the pages with tweezers and spotted the name The Gospel of Judas.

They tried to negotiate a deal for \$50-100,000 but the seller wanted 3\$ million. No Way. The story goes on. According to the present owners of the gospel, the antiquities dealer bought the manuscript from a village trader who made his living scouting out such materials. Exactly where or how the trader came across the collection is not clear. He's dead now.

The men went to lunch together and one of the scholars went into the bathroom and frantically tried to write as much as he could remember from the text. That was the last that anyone saw of it for 17 years.

Determined to get top dollar for it. The scholars confirmed for the Egyptian by their excitement that it was really

valuable - so he headed for New York to try to find a buyer. It led to nothing, so he lost heart and went back to Cairo and left the documents in a bank vault in Hicksville, NY for 16 years where they continued to disintegrate.

In April 2000, he sold it to a woman who paid a rumored \$300,000. She thought the Rare Book and Manuscript Library at Yale might be a buyer where she learned from their researchers that she had unbelievable materials... The Gospel of Judas of Iscariot.

But Yale didn't buy it, so she took it to an ancient manuscripts dealer who offered to give her 2.5 million for it. But he kept the documents and refused to pay her. After quite a battle she got it back and eventually sold it to National Geographic in 2001. An international team of scientists and scholars worked for four years to authenticate, conserve, and translate the manuscript. It has been carbon dated five times and translated and... what has emerged is: The Gospel of Judas.

Everyone remembers the story of Judas as told in the New Testament – Judas betrayed Jesus for thirty pieces of silver - identifying him with a kiss. Later, crazed with guilt, Judas returns the bribe and commits suicide.

However, the twenty-six page manuscript, The Gospel of Judas, gives a very different account. More than 1,700 years later now a long-buried side of early Christianity is re-emerging.
